The State Services Commission has been disclosing chief executive remuneration since 1998 for Public Service departments, tertiary education institutions and District Health Boards, with other Crown entities added in 2010.

The annual disclosure provides transparency for the public around the levels of remuneration received by chief executives.

The Senior Pay Report, including the disclosure of chief executive remuneration, sets out the remuneration of chief executives in the Public Service and State sector for the year to 30 June 2017. It also provides some analysis of remuneration increases and comparisons with other groups.


Accordingly, I have refused your request for the information contained in the documents listed in the above table under section 18(d) of the OIA – as the information requested is publicly available.
