## Official information request for information about the chief executive retreats Our ref: 2017/0053

I refer to your official information request received on 5 May 2017 for:

- In each year since 2009, how much funding has been allocated to the six monthly chief executives' (CEs) retreat, broken down by cost, venue and attendees
- Please also provide a list of attendees that were not present, and subsequent costs of their absence
- A breakdown of costs for external speakers, broken down by name, venue, and date
- Please also provide evaluation reports on the six monthly CEs retreat.

On 1 June 2017, we advised you that we were extending the timeframe for making our decision on your request, to 27 June 2017.

Since 2014, CEs have been meeting together as a group twice a year. These working sessions are an important part of how the leaders of the Public Service work together to drive the Better Public Services agenda faster to make a bigger difference, and to make sure that New Zealanders are getting the best outcomes from their public services.

CEs highly value the time together, and want to be able to increase the pace of how they are driving and leading change. Planning and collective decision-making occurs at these meetings and it is important to ensure that changes takes place in a timely way. As a result, in 2017 the CEs agreed to increase the number of CE meetings, from two to four per year (2 overnight meetings, and 2 one day meetings in Wellington).

The CE meetings are organised and convened by the State Services Commissioner. The State Services Commission (SSC) works hard to ensure that the costs for the meetings are kept as low as possible. Competitive rates for accommodation and transport are negotiated where possible, and some CEs share rooms and carpool to reduce costs. Since October 2016, the State Services Commissioner personally pays for all alcoholic beverages.

#### Cost of CE meetings and cost for non-attendees

Please find attached as Appendix 1 a table that covers, in each year since 2014, the total amount spent by SSC on each CE meeting, broken down by venue and, where possible, cost per attendee. Note that all costs are GST exclusive. To provide a full picture of the expenditure per meeting, we are also providing you with the following costs:

- catering
- transport (in Martinborough to a dinner venue, and in Auckland coach hire to venues and airport transfers)

- accommodation (none required at Boomrock, which was a day-long event)
- speakers' costs
- other costs (which are for internet usage, technical support, printing, stationery, and photocopying)

The catering and venue costs for the October 2016 CE meeting and the catering, venue, and travel costs for the January 2017 CE meeting are unable to be separately identified.

CEs pay individually for the cost of any airfares, where they are required. CEs also paid individually for the cost of their accommodation in October 2016.

For the CE meetings that took place in March 2014, September 2015, and March 2016, amounts were cost recovered by SSC from the CEs who attended the meeting. As a result, we are able to provide you the cost recovered per attendee in these years (accommodation and catering costs were shared across attendees, and differed by CE depending on their accommodation, e.g. single or shared room, and length of stay).

For the CE meetings that took place in September 2014, March 2015, October 2016, January 2017, and May 2017, SSC did not recover costs from CEs. We are unable, therefore, to break down the cost of the meetings per CE.

The table also lists the attendees that were not present at each CE meeting. We have provided you, where available, the cost for CEs who were, usually at short notice, unable to attend the CE meeting (either the full meeting or part of the meeting).

You should note that the costs for each CE meeting may include costs incurred by other attendees, such as catering for any local government and Public Servant speakers, and accommodation and catering for other SSC staff who attend in support.

#### **External speakers**

Below is a table that breaks down the amount paid to external speakers, by name, venue, and date. The costs include speakers' fees and any necessary travel and/or accommodation. Note that not all speakers were remunerated (e.g. local government and Public Servant speakers), so they are not included in the table below.

The information in the table below (excluding venue and the speakers from May 2017) is also publicly available in SSC's Annual Reviews on the New Zealand Parliament's website (https://www.parliament.nz/en/pb/sc/submissions-and-

#### **Evaluation reports**

Since October 2016, the State Services Commissioner invites CEs to complete a voluntary evaluation survey following each meeting, which are used to inform the style and content of future events. Attached are the evaluation survey reports from October 2016, January 2017, and May 2017.

While the overall ratings were, in some cases, measured out of five, the reporting tool presents the results on a scale of ten to ensure consistency. CEs' overall rating of the away days was measured out of five. Overall, CEs rated the away days between four and five in the three surveys.

I am releasing the three evaluation survey reports to you in part by providing you the responses to questions 1 and 2 of each survey. I am withholding the comments that have been provided in response to the remaining questions in full under the following sections of the OIA:

- 9(2)(ba)(i), to protect the information which is subject to an obligation of confidence or which any person has been or could be compelled to provide under the authority of any enactment, where the making available of the information would be likely to prejudice the supply of information from the same source, and it is in the public interest that such information should continue to be supplied
- 9(2)(g)(i), to maintain the effective conduct of public affairs through the free and frank expression of opinions by or between or to Ministers of the Crown or members of an organisation or officers and employees of any department or organisation in the course of their duty.

For your information, the questions that I am not releasing the responses to are as follows. Not all CEs answered each of these questions:

- What session did you find most useful? Why?
- What session did you find the least useful? Why?
- Were the guest speakers informative?
- What were your key take outs from the away days?
- If you have any further suggestions or feedback to help us improve the agenda for future away days, please state below
- Do you have any other comments, questions, or concerns?

In making my decision, I have considered the public interest considerations in section 9(1) of the OIA and do not consider that the public interest outweighs the interest in maintaining confidentiality.




# Q1 Overall, how would you rate the away days?

# Q1 Overall, how would you rate the away day?


